On November 13, our Capital Campaign Leaders, Tim Stevens and Jerry Singer, announced our *Living, Growing, and Giving in Faith* Capital Stewardship Campaign Goals.

**Our goal** is to extend the ministries, witness, and outreach of St. Christopher Episcopal Church. **Our goal** is to provide facilities that meet the needs of our congregation, both now and for the future. **Our goal** is to look for God's guidance and direction - seeking the ways in which God wants to work through each of us.

What is our **financial challenge**? INDIVIDUALLY, the challenge is for each of us to find the unique ways we can help to achieve our goal for our parish. For some it means a weekly or monthly offering beyond our current support. For others it means gifting a tangible asset to the parish (stock, bonds, property, etc.). For still others it means transforming time, talent, or ability into a financial gift to invest in the future of the parish. TOGETHER we want to go beyond the "milestones" set to gauge our commitment progress.

Leadership Challenge Point: \$500,000

Celebration Point: \$675,000

Prayerful Goal: 1,260,000

A Leadership Challenge point represents Leadership gifts which model sacrificial giving and teach our congregation commitment. The total of such advance commitments will be announced on December 11.

A Celebration point is stepping forward in faith, a testimony to God moving in our hearts and in our lives, leading each of us, and all of us together, to accomplish more than we imagined. Our objective is to meet or exceed our Celebration point by the Christmas Eve service on December 24.

Our prayerful goal is to provide the financial means to build Phase One of the Master Plan without debt. We pray for the generosity of sacrifice that we may know and do what is required of us to further God's work. Lord, what do You want to do through me to accomplish Your will for St Christopher Episcopal Church.

How far will our *Living, Growing, and Giving in Faith* Capital Stewardship Campaign take us? As far as we are willing to see. As far as we allow God to reach into our lives and as far as we are willing to commit ourselves.
